From the Pastor August 8, 2021 Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time – Eleventh Sunday After Pentecost

OUR LADY'S LENT: In many places of the Church, it is the custom and tradition to keep a fast beginning on August 1st until August 15th. It is given the charming name of *Our Lady's Lent*. It is a fast in honor of Our Lady as we celebrate her principal feast of the year on August 15th, the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. I would encourage our parishioners to follow this ancient spiritual practice.

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION: This year the Solemnity of the Assumption falls on a Sunday Augusts 15th. Beginning that weekend (14th and 15th) the Obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holydays will be reinstated. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and Holydays was dispensed in March 2020. That is now rescinded in a sign that things are returning to normal. What a wonderful way for the Obligation to return all as we honor Our Blessed Mother. Although the dispensation from the obligation is rescinded, we must remember that the Church Law itself dispenses those who are ill or caring for the ill, those who are travelling, those caring for infants, and other serious reasons from the obligation to attend Mass.

PARISH GOLF OUTING: Please save the date of Thursday August 19th for our annual Parish Golf Outing and Awards Dinner. Our honorees this year are Thomas and Irene Principe. As many know, the Golf Outing, along with the Gala Casino Night, are the two major fundraisers for our parish. In 2020 we were unable to have either of these events, and, as a result, our parish suffered a budget deficit. This year we will only be able to have the Parish Golf Outing and Awards Dinner. The Gala Casino Night will not be held this year because it would be separated from the Golf Outing and Awards Dinner by only six weeks. It is our fond hope that in 2022 we will be able to have both events once again.

Since there will be no Gala Casino Night this year, I am making a special request. I would like as many parishioners as possible to attend the Golf Outing and Awards Dinner on Thursday August 19th. Even attending the Awards Dinner only (without golfing) would be a wonderful thing for St. Paul's. The outing and dinner are at the Engineers Club in Roslyn and outdoor dining will be available. St. Paul's depends on this for our financial health.

Our annual income has three sources: Sunday collections, donations, and our two fundraisers. These are all vital for the health of our parish. As your pastor and priest, I would encourage you perhaps to consider suggesting that donations be made to St. Paul at the time of the Funerals of loved ones. Very often we may read that *in place of flowers, the family would like donations to be made to*...How nice it would be if the parish which was the center of the faith life of the beloved deceased would be remembered also.

Many of the events from the Casino Night (50/50, raffles, prizes) will be available the day of the Picnic. The parish picnic is a way to thank all parishioners. Admission is a gift, but we hope many parishioners will enjoy themselves and purchase the raffles.

ST. PAUL'S PICNIC: Our annual parish picnic will be held on **Sunday, September 12th.** It will begin at 12 noon and all parishioners are most cordially invited to attend. How nice it will be to greet our friends and fellow parishioners after we were unable to have the picnic last summer of 2020. September 12th is the Feast of the Most Holy Name of Mary and so we trust Our Lady to provide good weather that day.

Dear Social Ministry Coordinator:

As we gradually resume normalcy, we are faced with so many people who have lost loved ones to COVID, or who have lost family members due to other causes but were not able to receive the needed support because of CDC restrictions. We are resuming in-person support groups in our parish center for our parishioners as well as our neighbors in other parishes. We will be following CDC guidelines for indoor events.

Three groups are being offered:

A general bereavement group led by me for those with a recent loss. This group will focus on helping the bereaved learn about the bereavement process, develop coping skills for dealing with grief, and learn to adjust to living without their loved one. The group will consist of those who have lost a partner, a sibling, parent or other relative. It is a closed group that meets for ten weeks.

We also have two ongoing groups that meet twice a month:

Survivors of suicide loss and bereaved parents. These are specialized groups that deal with the challenges of losing a loved one to suicide, and the devastation of losing a son or daughter. I will lead the suicide group, and two trained, experienced bereaved parents will lead the child loss group.

There is a one-time registration fee of \$25 for all groups. Interested individuals need to register by contacting Sister Christine Sammons at 516-731-6074. She will mail you a registration form.

General Bereavement Group (meets weekly): Saturdays, September 18 - Nov 20, 11 AM to noon

Group for Bereaved Parents (meets 1st and 3rd Monday of the month): Mondays, September 20 – ongoing; 7:00 PM to 8:15 PM

Group for Survivors of Suicide (meets 2nd and 4th Monday of the month) Mondays, September 13 - ongoing; 7:00 PM to 8:15 PM

Additionally, we have not had any formal training for support group facilitators since the pandemic began. To help parishes resume their groups, we are offering training to become a support group facilitator. I will be conducting a six-week training program on Saturday mornings starting September 18 from 9:30 AM to 10:45 AM. There is a \$60 registration fee. Anyone who is interested please contact me directly.
