LENT IS APPROACHING

The Holy Season of Lent will begin on Ash Wednesday March 2, 2022. On that day we may come to the Church to receive the Blessed Ashes at 9.00a.m. Mass and at Prayer Services at 12.30p.m.; 4.30p.m. and 7p.m. Confessions will be heard after each of the times the Ashes are imposed. There will be the Stations of the Cross on each of the Fridays of Lent at 7.00p.m. The Marian Guild Lenten Evening of Prayer, to which we are all invited will be at 7.00PM on Wednesday March 16th. Our own Father Lee Descoteaux, who helps us every weekend, will present the Evening of Recollection. Many thanks to the Marian Guild.

OUR SUNDAY PRIESTS

We are very blessed to have two priests who help us each week at St. Paul's. This assistance is most necessary and appreciated in a one priest parish such as our own. Our assistant priests are Very Reverend Lee R. Descoteaux and Reverend Brand P. O'Brien. Both these fine priests are assigned to the Diocesan Tribunal in Rockville Centre. Each holds a Licentiate in Canon Law (J.C.L) from the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross (Santa Croce) in Rome. Holy Cross is considered as the Harvard of Pontifical universities. Bishop Barres holds both a J.C.L. and a Doctorate in Sacred Theology (S.T.D.) from Santa Croce. Father Descoteaux is presently the Judicial Vicar of the Diocese of Rockville Centre and Father O'Brien is the Adjutant (Assistant) Judicial Vicar. We are most grateful for their dedicated service. Each of them speaks beautiful Italian for those who like to confess in Italian.

SCHEDULE

Many are aware that two years ago we began to have a winter/summer schedule for the Saturday afternoon Mass. This was done to accommodate our parishioners who have difficulty in driving in the darkness. After trying this schedule for two years we will be returning to our former practice. **THE SATURDAY AFTERNOON MASS WILL REVERT TO 5.00PM BEGINNING SATURDAY MARCH 19TH** The Saturday afternoon Mass will then remain at 5.00PM throughout the year as most parishioners have asked. This will eliminate any confusion about Mass times and will afford us the opportunity to be of service to our young brides and grooms. Because Covid-19 forced so many young people to postpone and reschedule their weddings, St. Paul's has had the largest number of weddings in several years. Although a schedule cannot please everyone we appreciate your cooperation. Although in the late autumn the nights grow longer, we must remember that at Christmas the sun returns. There are merely 4 Saturdays when it would be night at 5.00PM

MORE HOURS FOR CONFESSION

More hours for confessions will be added to our schedule. We have confessions every Saturday afternoon. In addition to that time the Sacrament of Penance will be available Sunday mornings from 7.45AM until 8.15AM and 9.45AM until 10.15AM. In addition, we will have confessions on Wednesday morning after the 9.00AM Mass. It is my fervent prayer and hope that this will afford many more of our faithful to avail themselves of the graces of the Divine Mercy in the Sacrament of Penance. This will begin on the First Sunday in Lent, March 6, 2022. Just please be aware that on Sundays the priest will have to leave the confessional to prepare for Holy Mass.

Re: COVID-19 Protocols Update



The Governor of New York has announced that effective Thursday, February 10, 2022, masks are no longer required indoors. Please implement the following at your parish, no later than the weekend of February 12 - 13:

1. **Masks are optional.** You cannot require anyone to wear a mask. Masks are no longer required for the distribution of Holy Communion or at any other time but are optional. At present however, masks continue to be required for schools and healthcare facilities.
2. There are no social distancing requirements. As parishes were instructed in the Memo distributed to all priests on June 16, 2021, pew barriers were to be removed. If any parishes continue to have pew barriers, please remove them. As more people return to Mass, pew barriers force people to sit closer together and could discourage attendance.
3. Parishioners are not to be asked their vaccination status or for proof of vaccination. There is to be absolutely no segregating of worshipers based on vaccination status.
4. Also, as instructed in the June Memo, there are no disinfecting or contact tracing requirements. Please stop all practices such as the taking of temperatures, contact tracing and health questionnaires.
5. There are no restrictions on missalettes, hymnals or bulletins.
6. Parish offices and activities should be open and fully functioning. Lent and Ash Wednesday guidelines will be sent to you separately from the Office of Worship.
7. Please continue to encourage all Catholics to return to the celebration of Mass through evangelization and outreach.

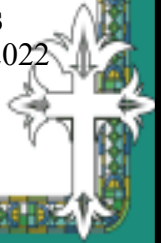

Due to the pandemic, we are taking special anti-COVID-19 precautions. Ashes will not be applied on the forehead. Ashes will be sprinkled on the top of each person's head.

Fast and Abstinence Church Regulations

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen years and older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. This obligation prohibits the eating of meat, but not eggs, milk products or condiments of any kind, even though made from animal fat.

Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a given fast day. Catholics who are eighteen years of age but not yet fifty-nine are obligated to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength. However, the two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Moreover, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted.
