#### What Makes the Transfiguration Central to the Faith

The Transfiguration—perhaps like the Ascension—is a mystery of faith that often receives too little of our attention and meditation. But in truth, it is a mystery at the very center of our faith. When St. John Paul II gave us the Luminous Mysteries, he considered the Transfiguration the mystery of light par excellence (see <u>Rosarium Virginis</u>, 21).

Why does this mystery strike at the heart of the Christian faith?

Because it shows forth the full divine glorification of humanity.


God's plan has never been merely about redemption and forgiveness of sins; God desires not only to forgive, but to heal and transform our fallen nature—to make us radiate through and through with his divinity.

What happens to Jesus is exactly the template for what the Holy Spirit wants to do in each of us. In this respect, the Transfiguration of Jesus is a foreshadowing of our own resurrection—the divine glorification not just of our souls, but of our bodies as well (see <u>CCC 556</u>).

And not coincidentally, the Transfiguration occurs right on the heels of Christ's first Passion prediction—teaching us that the suffering of the Cross culminates in triumphant glory and victory (see <u>Matthew</u> 16:21 and 17:1-5).
