Dear Parishioners of Our Beloved St. Paul.

Wonderful News! I am happy to tell you that St. Paul the Apostle will reopen (at first in a limited way) for Sunday and Daily Mass beginning the weekend of June 13/14

I am happy to tell you that we have entered Phase II of the NYS opening directives. Therefore, on the weekend of June 13/14 we will reopen (although on a limited basis). Holy Mass will be offered at **5PM on Saturday June 13th** (please note that it will not be the usual time of 4) and at **10 AM on Sunday June 14th**. Confessions will be heard from **4.00PM until 4.45PM** on Saturday.

Weekday Mass will resume on Monday, June 15th, but on a modified schedule for the time being. The weekday Masses will be celebrated on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays at 9:00am in the Church, not the Daily Mass Chapel. There will be no weekday Mass on Thursday or Friday.

Please note that as of now Holy Communion will not be distributed, but we hope that will change soon.

We are happy to announce the following guidelines that we have put in place for the safety of our parishioners and visitors:

- 1. Masks must be worn by all in the Church
- 2. Hand sanitizer will be available at the various entrances to the Church.
- 3. Pews will be marked for social distancing
- 4. The collection baskets will be at the doors of the Church for your offerings to the parish. The ushers will not take up a collection.
- 5. There will be no entrance procession, and no offertory procession for the present time.
- 6. The Parish office will reopen on Monday, June 15th. The office hours will be Monday through Thursday from 9AM until 4PM.

I have been so impressed with your generosity and goodness. Please remember that the Bishop has granted a dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. The sick or those whose health is compromised should not attend Mass for their own sake and for the sake of our parishioners.

SUPPLEMENTAL PUBLICATION

Reopening of St. Paul's for Weekend Masses June 13th & 14th

We are blessed to announce the resumption of weekend and weekday Masses at St. Paul's <u>with</u> the reception of HOLY COMMUNION.

One's physical presence at the celebration of Holy Mass, if they are able and comfortable, is immeasurably efficacious. To be physically present to our Lord in the Most Blessed Sacrament is of tremendous benefit to us.

Please see all the details below that will allow us to worship safely. Although we will resume being a community once again and gathering to "catch up" with fellow parishioners and friends as we are accustomed, we must be considerate of the well-being of all present.

- -all Masses, weekend and weekday, will be celebrated in the CHURCH with a MAXIMUM of 25% CAPACI-TY-approximately 175 people per Mass.
- -this weekend schedule will be Saturday 5:00pm and Sunday 10:00am. More will be added as needed in future weeks.
- -initially weekday Masses will be at 9:00am on **Monday**, **Tuesday and Wednesday ONLY** until further notice.
- -all in attendance MUST bring and wear masks or face coverings for the entire Mass when inside.

NOTE: Masks or facial coverings should not be worn by children under two years of age or by anyone with breathing difficulties. This should be widely understood so as to prevent conflicts between parishioners.

- -all should bring their own hand sanitizers and if, they wish, gloves as well.
- -seating will be in designated pews ONLY with proper 6 foot social distancing. Families/couples may sit together if they have been residing together during the "shelter at home period".
- -physical contact, handshaking, etc. is to be avoided and small cluster gatherings MUST take place outside the Church doors. Again, use caution and social distancing practices.
- Holy Communion <u>WILL</u> be distributed immediately at the end of Mass per the latest directive of June 10th from the Bishop's office. Instructions will be given at each Mass.
- -anyone who is recently recovered from the corona virus, anyone who has been recently exposed to the virus, anyone who has symptoms or feels ill **MUST REMAIN HOME.**
- -those who wish to be extra cautious, those caring for the elderly and vulnerable, those most vulnerable and the elderly are encouraged to remain in the comfort and safety of their homes and watch Mass on television or via digital video streaming.
- -although we will NOT have our formal collections, we would be most grateful if Parishioners could drop their envelopes into the collection baskets as they enter or exit.
- -please follow the instructions of the ushers and volunteers as they are there to assist us and keep everyone safe.

Important information

The dispensation for the obligation to attend Sunday Mass REMAINS IN EFFECT.

Confessions will be heard from 4.00PM until 4.45PM on Saturday.

We will continue to digitally stream the Mass as we have done these past two weeks on You Tube. See the Parish website, our Facebook page or FLOCKNOTE.COM for the link

The Church will be completely sanitized before this weekend with disinfectant and fogging agents.

The pews, entrances and bathroom will be sanitized after each of the Masses.

Please bring a copy of your own worship aid (i.e. Magnificat, Give Us This Day, etc.) as all missalettes have been removed from the pews. You may wish to also bring a copy of the *Spiritual Communion* prayer if you choose not to remain to receive Holy Communion. Bulletins will not be available however you may view the weekly bulletin on the Parish website.

All are asked to use ONLY the Main Parking area at the side of the Church and enter ONLY through the FRONT DOORS. Once inside the Church, other exits will be clearly marked.

Handicapped Parking remains at the front of the Church

While some of these measures are necessary for everyone's safety and may seem an inconvenience, we must remember how spiritually painful it was to be without Mass and Holy Communion for so many weeks. How blessed we truly are to come together once again on the Corpus Christi Sunday.


As we prayerfully wait for our Mass schedule to resume, please consider mailing in your Sunday offerings.
