### **The Fourth Commandment**

*From my grandfather I learned good morals and how to govern my temper.*

*From my father I learned modesty and manly character*

*From my mother piety and beneficence...and a simple way of living.*

Thus wrote the great Roman Emperor Marcus Aurelius in his book *Meditations*. In ancient Roman society the elderly were held in the highest veneration. 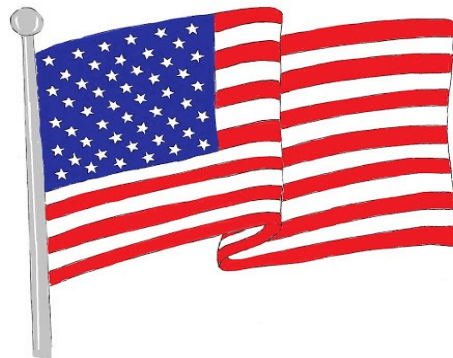

We are St. Paul's FOOD PANTRY... and we deliver!

Seniors and families with special needs are most vulnerable during these times and very often these people cannot get to our pantry so the risk of "food insecurity" is quite high.

They are also at greater risk of depression because of isolation.

Along with bags of food, we bring coffee then we spend some time talking... we even listen to music!

Evelyn, whose husband died last year, used to play the violin for him. She told us, "Frank loved "Clair de Lune", he said it was like a musical sunset."

We told her we'd love to hear it and so, while Evelyn played, we cried!

Then Evelyn said, "you can take back the food... You've given me what I was really hungry for...to play again"

St. Paul's also supports the efforts of other food pantries that, like us, have seen a great increase of families in need.
