FROM THE PASTOR JUNE 26, 2022 THIRD SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST THIRTEENTH SUNDAY THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

SPRING AT ST. PAUL'S

This springtime at St. Paul's has been a wonderful time of grace as we have moved through celebrating Our Lord's fast during Lent through His passion, death, and resurrection in Holy Week. Easter Sunday was a beautiful one at St. Paul's as the joyful alleluias rang out through our Church. The we moved through the Easter Season and celebrated Our Lord's wondrous Ascension and the glorious Solemnity of Pentecost. I am most grateful to all our parishioners who contributed to our Easter collection which amounted to \$40,000. Last Sunday on Corpus Christi we responded affirmatively to Our Lord's invitation, *Come follow me*, as followed Our Eucharistic Lord through the Church and outdoors for Benediction.

In May Bishop Murphy came to St. Paul's to confirm seventeen of our young people who had completed their two-year preparation for the sacrament. And twenty-four of our little ones made their First Holy Communion. On June 11th (just a few days before Flag Day) we had our annual Field of Honor Dedication. On June 2nd we had our fifth annual Golf Outing which raise more than \$150,000 for St. Paul's. We thank the Knights and the Committee and our honoree, Mr. Michael D. Sapraicone.

On Saturday June 18th three young men from Long Island were ordained priests. One of them, Father Christopher Heller, has many connections to St. Paul. His grandparents, Frank and Arlene, were parishioners when Bishop Kellenberg founded the parish in 1962. Father Heller celebrated his First Solemn Mass on Sunday, June 19th at St. Patrick's Church in Bayshore. And he celebrated his fourth Mass on Tuesday, June 21st here at St. Paul. It has been a great source of grace for us all. Father will celebrate the 8.30 Mass on Sunday the 26th and he will begin his first assignment as a priest on Wednesday, June 29th, at St. Dominic Oyster Bay. Deacon Ray served as Deacon at Father Heller's First Mass.



Monthly Catholic Devotions of the Church Year

Each month of the year is dedicated to a particular devotion within the Catholic faith; the dedication of each month is based on historical events or a particular aspect of the liturgical calendar, or a combination of the two. These monthly Catholic devotions do not line up exactly with the time frame of the liturgical calendar, since they are fixed to standard calendar months rather than the Church seasons.

Some countries and areas have developed monthly dedications to devotions more specific to their area, but the following are the common, widespread Catholic devotions for each month throughout the year.

- January is the month of the Holy Name of Jesus.
- ❖ February is the month dedicated to the Passion of Our Lord.
- March is the month of devotion to St. Joseph.
- ❖ April is the month dedicated to devotion to the Holy Eucharist.
- **❖** May is the month of Mary; devotion to the Blessed Mother.
- ❖ June is the month of the Sacred Heart.
- ❖ July is the month dedicated to the Precious Blood of Our Lord.
- **August** is the month dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- ❖ September is the month dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows.
- **October** is the month dedicated to Most Holy Rosary.
- ❖ November is the month dedicated to the Holy Souls.
- **❖** December is the month dedicated to The Divine Infancy of Jesus.
