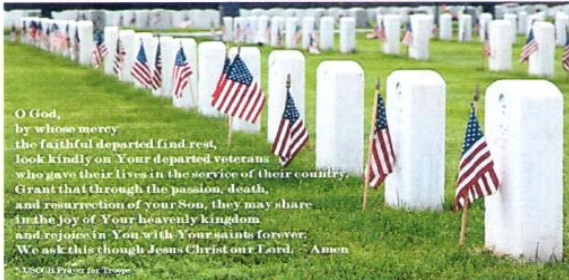

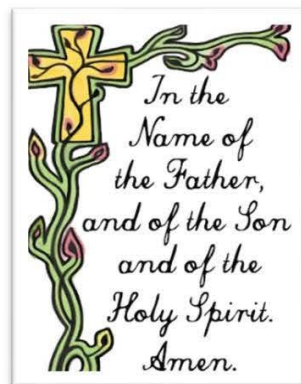


## Monthly Catholic Devotions of the Church Year

Each month of the year is dedicated to a particular devotion within the Catholic faith; the dedication of each month is based on historical events or a particular aspect of the liturgical calendar, or a combination of the two. These monthly Catholic devotions do not line up exactly with the time frame of the liturgical calendar, since they are fixed to standard calendar months rather than the Church seasons.

Some countries and areas have developed monthly dedications to devotions more specific to their area, but the following are the common, widespread Catholic devotions for each month throughout the year.

- ❖ January is the month of the Holy Name of Jesus.
- ❖ February is the month dedicated to the Passion of Our Lord.
- ❖ March is the month of devotion to St. Joseph.
- ❖ April is the month dedicated to devotion to the Holy Eucharist.
- ❖ May is the month of Mary; devotion to the Blessed Mother.
- ❖ June is the month of the Sacred Heart.
- ❖ July is the month dedicated to the Precious Blood of Our Lord.
- ❖ August is the month dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- ❖ September is the month dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrows.
- ❖ October is the month dedicated to Most Holy Rosary.
- ❖ November is the month dedicated to the Holy Souls.
- ❖ December is the month dedicated to The Divine Infancy of Jesus.



## **The Announcement of Easter and the Moveable Feasts 2022**

(On the Epiphany of the Lord, after the proclamation of the Gospel, a Deacon or cantor, in keeping with an ancient practice of Holy Church, announces from the ambo the moveable feasts of the 2022.)

+++++

**Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy, we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.**

**On the second day of March will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.**

**On the seventeenth day of April, you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

**On the twenty-sixth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

**On the fifth day of June, the feast of Pentecost.**

**On the nineteenth day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.**

**On the twenty-seventh day of November, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever.**

**Amen.**
