

Named for the white coats and uniforms worn by many health care professionals, White Masses are special opportunities to ask God's blessings for all those serving in the health care field.


The White Mass will be broadcasted on Catholic Faith Network (CFN), beginning at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, May 17. The Mass can be viewed any time after 11:00 a.m. on cfntv.org, drvc.org and on Diocese of Rockville Centre social media platforms. You can also watch CFN on Roku, Apple TV, Amazon Fire

TV and Android or by downloading the CFN iOS mobile app at the app store by searching for "Catholic Faith Network" or "CFN". In the tri-state area, the Mass will also air at 11 a.m. on WLNY-TV 55, Ch. 10 and on select CBS stations nationally, check local listings.



Once you sign up, your email (and text information, if provided) will automatically be sent <u>ONLY</u> to the Parish Flocknote system controlled by the Parish. Any future Parish notifications will be then sent to automatically.

Should you wish to join a specific group or groups, please review the groups and and make your request to join that group. This will allow you to receive group specific information.
