From the Pastor

May 26, 2019

THE SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

The week upon which we embark is a grace filled one indeed. Last week was National Police Officers Week and we pray for all who serve and protect us in the police department. Sadly, so many have lost their lives in the long blue line of duty. May God grant them eternal rest. Saturday of last week was Armed Forces Day. On that day we dedicated the Field of Honor prepared by our dear Knights of Columbus and Squires. The flags remain until Flag Day, June 14th.

ASCENSION THURSDAY (May 30th): Thursday May 30th is Ascension Thursday. It is the wondrous feast of Our Lord's return to heaven where He awaits us and where He has prepared a place for us. It is a **HOLYDAY OF OBLIGATION**. The Masses that day will be Wednesday evening at 7.30PM and on Thursday at 8.00AM and 12.15PM. Make every effort to attend Holy Mass that day. Interestingly, in England the Feast is called *Holy Thursday* and what we Americans call Holy Thursday (the Thursday before Good Friday) is called *Maundy Thursday* in England. *Maundy* is the Old English word for the Latin *mandatum* which refers to the foot washing ceremony. Please note the parish office will be closed in observance of the Holyday.

MEMORIAL DAY: This weekend we observe Memorial Day when we pray for and thank God for the service of those in the armed forces of our nation. The day began as a day when the graves of our fallen soldiers would be adorned with spring flowers. Thus the original name of the holiday, Decoration Day. (My good father always called the holiday "Decoration Day" until the day of his death 26 years ago. But he also called any sound system the "Victrola.") May God bless my fellow veterans and all who have served in the armed forces of our nation.

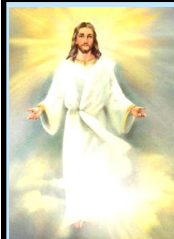
ANNUAL COMMUNION BREAKFAST: Last Sunday Our Knights of Columbus Council and Marian Guild sponsored our annual communion breakfast. This is always a most pleasant occasion when we get to greet our fellow parishioners and enjoy a delicious breakfast. Our guest speaker for the breakfast was Father Leo Song. Father Leo is a newly ordained priest who made his First Holy Communion here at St. Paul.

ST. RITA: Wednesday of last week, May 22nd was the Feast of Saint Rita of Cascia, the saint of the Impossible. She has worked innumerable miracles for her clients. I would encourage all of you to pray to her unceasingly. Over twenty five years ago a wonderful gentleman whom I had befriended while I was living and studying in Rome and his son (Andrea and Carlo respectively) drove me the great distance from Rome to St. Rita's shrine in Cascia (I had no use of a car while I was a student in Rome). The father Andrea had been miraculously spared when he was in a terrible car accident at the age of 17. He attributed the saving of his life to St. Rita and every year went to her shrine on her feast. How well I remember being with them that day many years ago. I even remember stopping for *pranzo* with them and eating delicious trout that had just been caught and had been roasted in aluminum foil. Sadly I have lost contact with Andrea and presume God has called him home where he may be with St. Rita forever. Ever since that day, I have been a devoted client of St. Rita and my mother, although her baptismal name was Marie, was known as Rita. It is she who also instilled into me a love of St. Rita, the *Saint of the Impossible*.

WHAT "Friday Friends" is a monthly event where children with special needs can bond with teen volunteers in the community on a one-to-one basis. Parents of children with special needs can drop off all their children (including siblings) and enjoy a break from their intensive caring routine.

COST: There is no cost to participate. We will provide pizza and water to all the kids.

We have assembled a group of compassionate high school students and adult volunteers. "Friday Friends" has worked so well at other parishes in the area on so many different levels.

For our special-needs parents: It is a rare night of relaxation.

For our special needs kids: It is a social activity that they really look forward to.

For our teen volunteers: This has helped our volunteers develop a sense of compassion and empathy that they might not have otherwise experienced.

As background, the "Friday Friends" program has been in existence for approximately three years in two local Syosset Churches - St. Dominic Catholic Church and St. Edward the Confessor Church. We are now opening this up in the Jericho/Brookville area at the Church of St. Paul the Apostle. As the "Friday Friends" program has ~135 regular participants in the two existing locations, this will allow this successful program to expand to help support the community and our special-needs parents as we now open this up in the Jericho/Brookville area at the Church of St. Paul the Apostle.

We will host this event once per month during the school year (September-June). We have many fun activities planned including arts & crafts, games, music, kickball, basketball, playground activities and more to ensure a good time for your child who is with us at "Friday Friends".

We hope that your child will join us! We recognize it takes a village to raise a child, and the same is even truer when a child has special needs which is why we look forward to offering this opportunity to join the Friday Friends family.

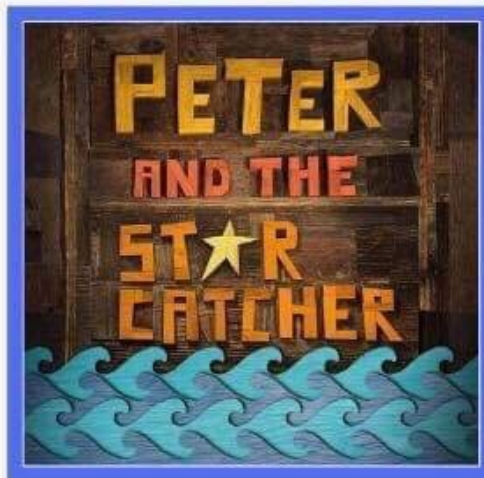
