Deacon Ray's 2021 Mission Trip to the Dominican Republic

Although we were unable to bring a large group to the Mission this year as we normally do and could not visit in 2020, I did have the opportunity to travel with Msgr. John Cervini, Jimmy Shaughnessy from the Basilica Parish of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, Southampton and Eugene Siani from St. Edward the Confessor in Syosset this year. We were there from Nov. 10-15. Jimmy and Eugene have made a number of trips to the Mission and Msgr. Cervini served there for 16 years. This was my 13th visit since 2006.

For the past 5 years, a number of our parishioners from St. Paul's have made generous donations to the Mission. Those contributions were used to fund the various building projects undertaken in the Mission; chapels, Sagrada Familia Vocational Technical School, greenhouses, medical clinics, schools and last year the new San Pedro Apostol Salon Parroquial (Parish Center) for the Faith Formation of Adults and Children.

To Msgr. Pereda for his constant support of the Mission and my work there, and to all at St. Paul the Apostle, **THANK YOU** and God reward you.

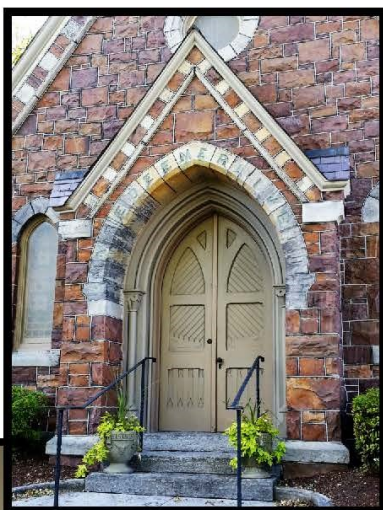
