From the Pastor September 17, 2023 Twenty Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time Sixteenth Sunday After Pentecost

THE LITTLE SISTERS OF THE POOR: Thank you most sincerely for providing such a beautiful welcome to the Little Sisters of the Poor who visited our parish on the weekend of September 2nd and 3rd. As many know, the Little Sisters of the Poor are an international Religious Institute of Pontifical Right, working in all corners of the earth.

Their work is exclusively caring for the elderly poor. They do not teach in schools or work in hospitals or parishes. They invite the elderly poor into their homes and there care for them. Both my mother and father died at the Home of the Little Sisters of the Poor, and, as many know, before my arrival at St. Paul's I served as Chaplain of the Novitiate of the Little Sisters of the Poor in Queens Village.

Our parish has always been a great supporter of the Little Sisters of the Poor. Three families from our parish have been honored by them at their Annual Golf Outing: Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Fitzsimmons, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Palumbo, and Mr. and Mrs. Robert Fitzsimmons. They have had the honor of having the Circle in front of the Home named after them. Mr. and Mrs. Frank Gullo of our parish provide the elderly poor with fresh fish each week from their company, Gullo Seafood. And all of St. Paul's helps them in every way. Some of young people serve as volunteers in the Home.

The Little Sisters collected \$5,510 during their visit to St. Paul's. As I said at the time of their visit, they are happy to be known as Beggars. That is why they themselves hold the basket at the door, just like their Foundress St. Jeanne Jugan. Sister Mary Alexander told me this is the largest amount ever collected in their Church collection since she has arrived at Queen of Peace.

May God bless and reward your generosity.

PLEASE JOIN US

Fr. Michael J. McGivney, an Irish American parish priest from the late 19th century, ministering in New Haven, Connecticut, where the Knights of Columbus headquarters and museum stand today, founded this religious organization as an Associate Pastor of St. Mary's Church with a small number of his parishioners. He died at the young age of 38 (1852-1890).

The original ministering intent of the Knights was to address the financial needs of immigrants and their families as they came to America. The Knights of Columbus has grown into the world's largest fraternal organization with charitable giving each year that reaches into the many millions of dollars, assisting in the worst natural and unnatural disasters in our nation and throughout the world. And it all began with an idea, a hope, a vision that was small, yet has grown to great heights.

Fr. McGivney is probably shaking his head in heaven, looking down at the widespread love and goodness that continues to flow from his idea of financial assistance to immigrants, saying, "I never thought it would grow into something this great and good, from our little spot in New Haven. But, as we all know up here, God will take a small idea of love that He sends to us through his grace and turn it into a worldwide cause."

This is the present-day Knights of Columbus. They are a force of goodness ready to step in first when trouble is at hand. These groups of Catholic men are much more than a pancake breakfast with sausage and bacon. They are in *persona Christi*, they are in the Person of Christ throughout the world, not asking for Catholic identification from those they serve, but rather, they serve anyone without hesitation where help is needed.
